

Validating, Empowering and Navigating Together


Casual and safe weekly space for international students to discuss (or vent) their daily challenges. Students can use this space to connect, support, and validate one another, AND receive guidance and resources.

How to use ucsb Global

What form do I need?

Familiarize yourself with the different services OISS offers on the Student Services menu. Tip: Some services are nested under these main categories!



How do I track my request?

Submitted requests might need approval from second-approvers. Keep an eye on progress at the bottom of your homepage under the Requests tab. If the form says "Routed to Third Party" that means it is awaiting processing from another office before it reaches OISS for review.

How do I know when my request is approved or denied?

Check your Notifications on the Home Page, or up on the bell-icon at the top right. Here you can see when you've gotten the final approval or denial on your request. Tip: Check your email inbox, also! Your assigned

OISS advisor will email you a confirmation (sometimes with important documents attached!) Read carefully incase further action is required by you.
