Required Immigration Check-In-

It's the start of a new academic year! What better time to make sure your immigration status is in good standing so that you may focus on success for this Fall 2025 quarter and the rest of the academic year.

New F-1/J-1 Students

All new students must complete required check-in forms by **October 10, 2025**. Failure to complete all required check-in forms will result your SEVIS record being auto-terminated and you will have to depart the US.

To complete your check-in, you must:

- 1.Log into UCSB Global
- 2. Select "New & Returning Students Start Here"
- 3. Submit the New Student Local Address e-form
- 4. Submit the New Student Arrival Documents e-form



New & Returning Students

- Update your local living address in UCSB Global
- Ensure you're enrolled full-time
 - Undergraduate students: minimum of 12 credits
 - Graduate students: minimum of 8 credits


